At the center of the tapestry, the rooster--the painter's emblematic motif--stands majestically in the heart of a blazing sun. Its plumage, rendered with remarkable precision, combines patterns of shimmering scales and ocellated feathers. Around the solar disk, blazing rays stretch across a celestial black background studded with sparks, creating a striking chromatic contrast between fire, night, and vegetation.
