A painter of history, genre scenes, landscapes, and murals, he is considered the champion of the Opal Coast. He developed a body of work that stood somewhat apart from contemporary aesthetic trends. One notices his mastery of composition in his historical paintings, but one particularly appreciates his landscapes, which play a major role in his reputation. And he manages to infuse his canvases--though marked by a gray tone--with great luminosity. He died in Le Lavandou
