Description

Painting by Charles LEVIER (1920-2003), fairly typical of the artist's work. It depicts a young woman on a pier (Paris?) wearing a 1930s-style coat and hat, holding a large bouquet of flowers. A cathedral is visible in the background. The tones are soft--on one side, a symphony of roses; on the other, shades of gray and blue. The signature appears in the lower right corner; on the reverse, it is countersigned and titled. Oil on canvas. Dimensions: 100 x 73 cm. Charles LEVIER (1920-2003) was a Franco-American artist. His first solo exhibition took place at the Galerie Constantine in Lyon in 1949, followed by his American debut in Los Angeles in 1950. His work is part of the figurative movement known as "Les Trente Glorieuses." Inspired by Hollywood cinema, Charles Levier employs harmony and

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purity in his creations, which depict a delicate and luminous world, featuring subtle hues and carefully studied color palettes.
