### Description

Cylindrical inkwell with a tapered neck secured by a brass band that holds the lid in place. The lid is adorned with a bouquet of wildflowers and the crowned ND monogram, the emblem of the Notre-Dame de Lourdes. This symbol combines the royal crown, a sign of Mary's glory, and the letters ND, the initials of Notre-Dame. The lower section, elegantly decorated with floral motifs, evokes the lily, a symbol of purity and devotion. The glass inkwell, with its ribbed relief and iridescent hues of orange-yellow, green, and purple, is of a quality and craftsmanship comparable to the works of the famous Austrian glassworks Loetz. Whether in daylight or under artificial light, the colors of this inkwell shift from green to purple, passing through yellow and orange. Unsigned. In very good condition with its
