Description

Here is a beautiful 1947 edition of the first novel about China by Pearl Buck (1892-1973), known as Zenzhu to the Chinese, who embraced her as a national writer. From her earliest childhood, she lived in China with her missionary parents, immersing herself in Chinese culture, of which she became a champion. Her epic novels achieved international success, and in 1938 she was awarded the Nobel Prize in Literature. This French translation is illustrated with lovely engravings, with the colors applied using a stencil by Raymond Gérard, known as Gérard-Mond (1892-1980), a Parisian painter and illustrator. This is a numbered edition printed on vellum, in very good condition.
