Maffrash are the largest carrying bags once used by the nomadic peoples of Persia and the Caucasus. Often embroidered or made using the Sumak technique, this type of item is much more rarely woven, as is the case here. The colors are very soft and in perfect harmony, with a vibrant touch...
