The tang plates are made of mother-of-pearl
The guard features an eagle with outstretched wings on either side, and the pommel features a resting eagle.
The scabbard is made of light green stingray leather, with silver-plated brass fittings.
Blade length: 710 mm (diamond-shaped cross-section with two cutting edges), engraved on both sides.
Total length of the sword in its scabbard: 880 mm
