A charming inkwell shaped like a horse-drawn carriage pulled by two horses; the roof opens to reveal a porcelain cup with gold trim. The carriage is made of silver-plated bronze, the horses of matte bronze, and the floor, along with certain details such as the doors and the drawbar, are also in matte bronze--giving the piece an appearance that is both elegant and whimsical. The carriage sits on a gilded bronze base designed to resemble cobblestones. There is no manufacturer's mark on this object, but it may have been a custom-made or master craftsman's piece, suggesting that it is a one-of-a-kind item dating from the mid-19th century. Showing signs of wear, particularly on the roof of the inkwell, this beautiful object was not merely decorative; it was both practical and a pleasure to look at. Carefully packaged for
