Solid silver sugar spoon from the Louis XV period, featuring the rare "filets coquilles" design. Magnificent openwork decoration centered around a central rosette composed of teardrops and tulips. Hallmarks (crowned "A" with floral scrolls) and maker's mark (helmeted head in profile) for PARIS 1768-74, Guild hallmark for PARIS 1771 (crowned "H") and master silversmith's mark. Louis XV-era sugar spoon in the rare "filets coquilles" design, in very good condition with minor surface scratches from use.
