Anthropomorphic bottle or flask with yellow glaze from southern France (lead-glazed), depicting a monk with his breviary. The brick-red or dark ochre clay confirms its origin in southern France (Provence or the Gard). This is a traditional potter's piece intended for domestic use, likely to hold liqueur or oil. Good condition. From southern France, late 19th or early 20th century.
