A set of two reticulated plates decorated with famille rose enamels of fruits, vegetables and flowers motifs. China, 18th Qianlong period (1736-1795) Diameter : 23cm/23.5cm Provenance: Private European collection The central decoration features an abundance of flowers, fruits, and vegetables, forming a rich and expansive representation of the botanical world. Among the identifiable elements are pomegranates, grapes, Buddha's hand citrons, a bouquet of carrots, turnips, and peonies. The arrangement of flowers, fruits and vegetables is reminiscent of the so-called "Cornucopia" design (see Christie's, New York, Chinese Export Art Featuring the Hodroff Collection, Part IV, lot 355), in which European flowers emerge from a horn of plenty. Although the two designs differ in

several respects, and dating the comparison seems relevant and revealing. A 3mm chip on the reverse edge, and a tiny chip on the edge of one plate. A 1 mm firing line on the other. More information and photos available upon request.
