BRONZE SCULPTURE DEPICTING THE GOLDEN BOOK Signed MATHURIN MOREAU(1822-1912)Bronze with a brown patina and marble,Figure of a winged woman writing in a book resting on a column of Maurin green marbleSigned MATH MOREAU and bearing the stamp of the foundry of the Société des Bronzes de Paris.About :Mathurin Moreau was a French sculptor who worked in the traditional academic style of the 19th century. Born in Dijon on November 18, 1822, he was the son of the famous sculptor Jean-Baptiste Moreau. In 1841, he enrolled at the École des Beaux-Arts in Paris and, the following year, won the Second Grand Prix de Rome with his sculpture *Dionysus Carrying Off the Palladium*. Several of his works are on public display in Paris and

Cologne, including on the façade of the Gare du Nord, **L'Océanie** in the courtyard of the Musée d'Orsay, and **Zénobe Gramme** at the Père Lachaise Cemetery. In 1897, he received the Medal of Honor from the Paris Salon and was elected mayor of the 19th arrondissement, a position he held until his death on February 14, 1912.
