Description

Brass mount. Hunter-style guard with three side prongs. Main shaft signed "Versailles," hallmarked "B.D" within an oval by Brouilly, inspector from September 1800 to November 1805. Guard with remnants of an "LF" hallmark? Long-tailed pommel. Wooden grip wrapped in black waxed calfskin, with an oval brass stud on each side. Curved, hollow-edged blade, 88 cm long, with the back marked "Manufacture de Solingen K.S & C." Iron scabbard with wooden end caps and half-round ring fittings. Total length of the weapon: 106.5 cm. Very good condition. France. First Empire.
