This impressive desk features no fewer than eighteen oak-lined drawers (nine on each side), providing generous, well-organized storage. The top retains its original tooled and embossed brown leather writing surface, framed by a classic thumb-molded mahogany edge. Below, two substantial pedestals each contain four drawers with their original brass fret plate handles, all raised on a plinth base with concealed casters for ease of movement. In excellent original condition, the desk displays a glorious, rich mahogany color and a warm, mellow patina developed over more

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than two centuries, echoed by the characterful surface of the leather. Finished all around, it is designed to stand freely in a room, making it ideal as a true partner's desk and allowing for flexible placement within an interior. The proportions, detailing, and overall integrity of the piece clearly reflect the skill of the Georgian cabinetmaker and the careful stewardship it has enjoyed since circa 1790. This is a very fine example of Georgian library furniture, successfully combining exceptional craftsmanship, elegance, and practicality. Equally suited to an office, library, or study, this partner's desk serves as a superb focal point and a highly functional workpiece. It is an ideal choice for any refined interior seeking a genuine late 18th-century statement piece of outstanding quality and lasting utility.
