Description

Pair of late 18th-century gilded bronze candlesticks in the Louis XVI style. They rest on a circular base finely chased with rows of pearls, striations, and foliage accompanied by clusters of berries. The shaft begins with a floral motif; a band chiseled with a double row of pearls frames a conical section featuring deep fluted grooves. The bowl is intricately crafted and decorated with the same floral motifs as the base. The candlesticks are period pieces, adorned with a row of pearls around the rim. They bear a foundry mark: S. They have not been restored and retain their beautiful original gilding.
