Moroccan silver dagger known as a "koumya"--Morocco, Agadir, mid-20th century Bone handle with silver accents. Chiseled silver scabbard. Curved, double-edged blade. Blade etched and gilded on one side. Also engraved with the name of the city of Agadir. The silver bears several hallmarks certifying "ram's head" silver (a hallmark adopted in Morocco in 1925).
