



Antique 19th-century Tablecloth Made Of Silk With Petit Point Embroidery

Description

A 19th-century textile artifact made of black silk, adorned with a wide band entirely embroidered in petit point, and edged on all four sides by a 10-cm-long black fringe. The black fringe around the perimeter, featuring multicolored pom-poms spaced approximately 10 cm apart, is the most interesting feature of this textile: it is still in good overall condition, despite the absence of three pom-poms. At the four corners are beautiful tassels, 25 cm long. The tablecloth is lined with white fabric and padded with batting. Condition: The black silk of the background, especially along the perimeter, shows significant deterioration due to age, a common occurrence in silk fabrics of this era. The embroidered band is in good condition, with a few small missing sections. The fringe is missing
