Description

An elegant Roman micromosaic plaque crafted from minute polychrome glass tesserae, depicting a delicate naturalistic composition featuring three small birds arranged around an elegant open casket, embellished by a butterfly and a small flowering branch. The extraordinary finesse of the workmanship, the rich color palette, and the perfect uniformity of the white background attest to the exceptionally high quality of the Roman mosaic workshops active between the late 18th century and the early 19th century. Intended for travelers on the Grand Tour, these micromosaics were among the most refined and sought-after artistic souvenirs of the era. The plaque is in excellent condition and constitutes a precious example of Roman mosaic art from the Neoclassical period.
