Description

A large bouillabaisse dinner set consisting of 57 pieces, including: A covered soup tureen, A sauce boat, 3 serving dishes, 19 dinner plates, 13 soup bowls, 20 small round plates. With the exception of the round plates, each piece is shaped like a fish, a direct reference to its function. Featuring brown-ochre colors accented with speckled green highlights, they are crafted in relief to mimic the scales and anatomy of fish. Mark on the reverse: "MARIUS GIUGE / ARTISAN POTIER / VALLAURIS". Marius Giuge (1909-1980) was a French ceramicist active in Vallauris from the 1950s to the 1970s. He is best known for his tableware sets and decorative objects featuring speckled or marbled designs. A few chips are present on various pieces. Good overall condition. Dated to the 1960s.
