Carved and gilded wooden altarpiece element or tabernacle door - 18th century An important religious ornament made of carved, molded, and gold-leafed wood, likely a tabernacle door or a panel from an altarpiece; a French work from the 18th century. The panel features a Latin inscription in relief at its center: "PAVETE AD SANCTUARIUM MEUM EGO DOMINUS" ("Honor my sanctuary, I, the Lord" - Leviticus 19:30). The decoration features an elegant rococo frame adorned with pearls, foliage, and small flowers, typical of religious ornamentation from the second half of the 18th century. The original gilding retains a beautiful patina with signs of wear that enhance its authenticity. The reverse reveals an oak panel mounted on the original frame. Condition: in good
