A set of seven Louis XIV-style chairs crafted from solid walnut, richly carved with ribbon and bead friezes, drapery, and garlands of small flowers. Central monogram to be deciphered. The seventh chair is slightly shorter (2 cm) and lacks the finial on the front crossbar (certainly a piece intended for the master or mistress of the house). Work of very fine quality, with carvings that are both generous and very delicate. Beautiful burgundy red wool velvet upholstery. An exceptional piece from the late 19th century. In very good condition; firm seats; woodwork with no looseness or weakness; upholstery also in very good condition (no stains, tears, or discoloration; note only a few corners with slight surface wear--no holes).
