Small cubist-style bronze trinket dish or ashtray from the 1930s, depicting a seated cat. This is a Master's thesis project or an art school piece. The clearly visible file marks confirm that this is an antique, handcrafted piece, not a modern, mass-produced industrial reproduction. The Art Deco movement and Cubism of the 1930s were based on extremely precise geometric lines. This modernist style provided an excellent technical exercise for apprentice casters, engravers, and copper smiths.- As part of an exam, a workshop competition, or a master's project to become a journeyman, the student would create a piece to demonstrate their technical skill.
