The structure, crafted from finely carved and gilded wood, features sumptuous openwork decoration in the full Baroque style, enhanced by antique gilding perfectly preserved in its patina. The sculpted legs and rich ornamental interlacing lend the piece a sculptural monumentality of great aesthetic impact. The contoured top is crafted from fine "Fior di Pesco" marble, with refined polychrome veining, perfectly complementing the
