The glasswork displays a particularly beautiful harmony of colors: a luminous background with pale yellow and bluish hues is enlivened by a floral design in mauve and deep purple. The different layers of glass create stunning effects of depth and transparency despite the piece's miniature size. The naturalistic design, characteristic of Gallé's style, flows harmoniously around the entire vase. "Gallé" cameo signature within the design. Please note, as clearly visible in

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the photographs, a small chip measuring approximately 3 mm on the upper edge of the neck. This can be repaired or minimized by a restorer specializing in glassware.
