Description

The Les Merciers Gallery is privileged to present this spectacular sculptural lamp, produced by the legendary Maison Jansen in Paris during the 1960s and 1970s. A perfect embodiment of the sophisticated extravagance of the grand Parisian interiors of that era, this monumental piece transcends its primary function as a light fixture to become a true work of art. Directly inspired by the fascinating aesthetic of cabinets of curiosities, it showcases a genuine tortoise shell with rich amber hues. The shell is enhanced and supported by the precise architecture of a two-tiered solid gilded brass base, topped by an elegant brass finial. At the back of the structure, an ingenious concealed lighting system (with dual sockets) backlights the shell, diffusing a warm, textured glow throughout the room. Condition and
