Description

The Virgin in prayer, standing on a crescent moon, surrounded by a cloud shaped like cherub heads. There are countless ways to depict the Virgin: in prayer, with her hand on her heart, holding the Child, in Majesty, crushing the serpent, in the Pietà, the Assumption, the Sorrows... Our Virgin Mary expresses her full femininity here by standing on a crescent moon. Wearing a silver crown, she thereby signifies that she is Queen of Heaven and Earth. Carved in the round from wood, this piece is beautifully polychromed. The crown, the halo, and its twelve stars are made of silver. The number 12 refers to the Book of Revelation: "A great sign appeared in heaven: a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars. The entire piece rests on a
