Description

An important Japanese vase in an archaic "hu" form, made of bronze with a brown patina and polychrome cloisonné. Decorated with lotus flowers and phoenixes arranged in horizontal registers against a background of motifs imitating leiwen (patterns known as "lightning bolts" or "diamond meanders"), the neck flanked by two zoomorphic handles. Apocryphal Xuande mark under the base. Appraisal by the Portier Cabinet. A slight dent, barely visible (photo). Period: late 19th century, Meiji era (1868-1912). Dimensions: height 45 cm, weight over 5 kg. Good condition.
