Vintage mahogany office armchair, "Return from Egypt" Front legs in claw-foot style and rear legs in saber-foot style; armrest supports carved with caryatids wearing the nemes, backrest featuring an openwork lattice of crossbars and palmettes and a wide curved band, inspired by the klismos chair model that launched the Etruscan style The decoration of the backrest lattice is comparable to a set of twelve chairs delivered in 1800 for the Tuileries Palace, then installed in 1807 at Fontainebleau in the dining room of Prince's Apartment No. 4.
