Audoux Minnet-style coffee table in rattan and ceramic by Georges Chassin. The bamboo frame and tabletop feature ceramic tiles with a floral pattern, signed by Chassin. 1960s. Dimensions: H 44 L 79 P 49 cm. Georges Chassin, a ceramic artist from Vallauris in the 1960s, is featured at La Bergerie. He worked notably with Audoux and Minnet on various rattan pieces. Audoux-Minnet is a manufacturer of high-end garden, patio, and lounge furniture made of rattan, bamboo, and raffia cord. In the 1940s and 1950s, the designer couple Adrien Audoux and Frida Minnet created original and modern furniture made from natural materials for the affluent clientele of the Riviera (Côte d'Azur). Initially based in Cannes in 1929, they moved to Golfe-Juan (Alpes-Maritimes) in 1942.
