Fortunino MATANIA (1881-1963) Caratacus and the Britons (or Caractacus and the Britons) Artist: Fortunino MATANIA (1881-1963), an Italian painter and illustrator renowned for the archaeological accuracy and masterful realism of his historical scenes. Title: Caratacus and the Britons (a scene depicting the Gaelic/British chieftain Caratacus addressing his people or teaching among his own). Technique: Gouache and wash in shades of gray / grisaille on paper (original illustration). Composition: A lively historical scene with a meticulous academic composition. In the foreground, draped or nude male and female figures listen to the seated, bearded sage/leader, who is surrounded by children and holding a manuscript. Presentation: Work presented with a gold-edged mat, in a
