Large cast-iron fireplace plate. Renaissance style with a large salamander motif (dragon) surrounded by flames. Two "restyled" fleurs-de-lis punctuate the design. Typical of the coats of arms of Francis I. The plate is slightly cracked at the bottom. This is likely a copy made in the early 20th century, judging by the relative uniformity of its non-visible side. Dimensions: Length = 111 cm; height = 90 cm; thickness = 3-4 cm.
