Description

An old copper grain measure, also known as a "ferrat," from the 18th century. Made from a single sheet of hammered copper reinforced with copper strips, ferrats could be either simple or of fine quality, depending on the customer's preference. On this one, the craftsman created an interlaced pattern across the top of the sheet through his hammering. Other engraved decorations adorn the strips and reinforcements. The entire assembly (handles, bands) is held together by copper rivets. Despite its age and several very old repairs and modifications, this ferrat's patina is superb.
