Description

A beautiful pair of Louis XIII-style armchairs in walnut, with high backs. Each armchair rests on four "sheep's bone" legs, connected by an H-shaped crossbar--also in the "sheep's bone" style--as is the upper crossbar connecting the two front legs. Each backrest is steeply raked, providing great seating comfort. The armrests are fitted with fully upholstered sleeves and rest on console-style supports. The seat is very comfortable, having been recently reupholstered (see photo). The upholstery, meanwhile, was done with a fine-stitched tapestry; please note the presence of a very small stain on the front of the seat of one of the armchairs (see photo). Beautiful studded finish in aged brass. A few minor, routine repairs have been made to the tips of the legs (see photo). Note a slight chip on a crossbar of the leg
