Description

Pair of Art Nouveau-era chairs, Nancy School, 1900. They feature tall, molded and carved wooden backs, adorned with a remarkable stylized floral motif with long, sinuous lines, characteristic of the naturalistic vocabulary of Art Nouveau. The highly vertical design of the backs gives the set a particularly decorative silhouette. The seats are upholstered with woven straw, while the turned legs are joined by crossbars. The wood has a beautiful antique patina. A few marks and signs of wear are visible, particularly on the reverse of the backrests, consistent with the age of the chairs.
