Antique portable prayer wheel known as Ashtamangala; a Buddhist ritual object made of copper and brass, adorned with cabochon-cut turquoise and coral semi-precious stones. Features the Buddhist mantra "Om Mani Padme Hum" engraved on its surface. Contains paper scrolls with prayers and mantras, intended to be spun to release blessings. The counterweight chain is missing. Origin: Nepal. Period: first half of the 20th century.
