Description

Set of four Italian wall sconces made of thick iridescent glass from Murano, attributed to Carlo Nason for A.V. Mazzega, produced in the 1960s and 1970s. Each sconce consists of a transparent, geometrically shaped glass element enveloping a central section with opaline blue hues. Depending on the angle of light and its temperature, the glass reflects shades of blue, lilac, opalescent tones, and a hint of gold. White-painted metal wall bracket, concealed behind the glass. The four wall sconces are of the same model and form a cohesive set. They can be installed individually or arranged in a series. Dimensions of each wall sconce: Height: 38 cm Width: 18 cm Depth: 14 cm Signs of wear consistent with the item's age. Variations, irregularities, and the natural effects of the glass are visible in the photographs.
