Three-piece toilet garniture in pink opaline glass cased with white, comprising a perfume bottle with its original stopper, a covered box and a water glass (or beaker). Each piece is richly decorated by hand with black acanthus scrolls and leafy arabesques, highlighted with gilt scrolls and lines. Napoleon III period, circa 1850-1870. Perfume bottle with stopper: H 29.5 cm, D 11 cm. Covered box: H 17.5 cm, D 12 cm. Glass / beaker: H 12.5 cm, D 9.5 cm. Very good condition. This elegant pink opaline garniture is distinguished by the vibrancy of its pastel hue, internally lined with a milky white opaline layer. The refined black and gold enamel decoration, with motifs inspired by Renaissance and Second Empire ornament, perfectly illustrates the expertise of the great French and Bohemian
