Description

Individual glass cooler made of mold-blown glass, entirely honeycombed and decorated with two male heads in the form of mascarons; the rim is adorned with fillets, and the base features an irregular ribbon pattern created with pliers. 18th century. Dimensions: height 10 cm - diameter 10.5 cm. A restored crack is visible to the right of one of the mascarons. Early signs of glass deterioration affecting the entire surface of the object.
