Large marine chest made of camphor wood, with its brass plates and brass corner reinforcements to protect the corners, two brass side handles for carrying, and a central lock with a working key. Camphor wood was used on ships because it repelled insects. Finished on all four sides, this chest can serve as a coffee table or a bar, and is very practical for storing bulky linens.
