Georges Barwolf (1872-1935) was a Belgian painter born in Brussels and active notably in Paris. He specialized in landscapes and urban scenes, particularly Parisian streets, squares, and boulevards. He exhibited at the Salon des Indépendants and the Salon d'Automne in the early 20th century. In "Street Scene in Paris", Barwolf depicts a lively street with pedestrians, shops, and trees beneath a grey sky. The subdued tones are enlivened by colorful shop signs, while the loose brushwork captures the vibrant atmosphere of early 20th-century Paris.
