



Vintage 19th-century Iron Lantern, Restored

Description

An elegant and "rare" lantern made of wrought iron and openwork iron, with six beveled panels featuring cut-out fleur-de-lis motifs, resting on small feet, the openwork "cap" featuring a scroll motif. Period piece, restored between 1815 and 1830, a time when, following the classical tradition, the style evolved into the Neo-Gothic movement driven by Romanticism, with the famous architect Viollet-le-Duc. The lantern presented here is a fine "example" of this style.
