Double-circle mark on an unglazed background on the reverse. Chips on the tips of 8 of the palmettes. No other damage or visible restoration under UV light. DIAM. 18 CM (7 1/16 IN.) Provenance: François Bartoli, First-Class Administrator in the Indochinese Civil Service, Provincial Chief in Sadec, then stationed in Saigon from 1913 to 1929.
