Christofle Gallia Art Deco silver-plated metal bread basket, early 20th century. Created by the French silversmiths at Christofle for its Gallia line, this silver-plated metal bread basket radiates the ingenuity of Art Deco design, blending practicality and beauty. The Gallia collection was born at the dawn of the 20th century, reflecting Christofle's desire to embrace emerging design trends with increasingly ingenious creations that were more "accessible" to lovers of tableware. Silver-plated metal was a revolution at a time when only silver was considered a worthy and proper metal in French tableware, opening the door to a more affordable alternative for households with more modest means. Today, the pieces in the Gallia collection are timeless and true collector's items, as seen here with this wire
