Biography Clément Massier is considered the founder in the early twentieth century of Vallauris industry. He learned the technique of glazed earthenware that will make the reputation of the house Massier. Therefore these artistic pieces are distinguished from local crafts. It performs passionate research in the development of new types of tiles with metallic reflections
It's at the Universal Exhibition in 1889 he exhibited this new type of ceramic.
