One of them has significant damage, visible in the photographs. Portor marble is distinguished by its deep black background crisscrossed with broad golden veins, creating a particularly rich and decorative contrast. This luxurious material, now rare, enhances the precious character of this desk accessory. The set rests on four small bronze feet. The marble is in very good overall condition,
