Description

According to the earliest martyrologies, Saints Abdon and Sennen were two martyred brothers who died around 250 after enduring the most horrific tortures in Córdoba, then under the reign of Emperor Decius of Babylon, and were subsequently buried with honors thanks to two local princes who recovered their bodies. These images are mounted under oval convex glass panels edged in bronze and framed within an engraved alabaster diptych embellished with gilded appliqués.
