decorative explorations of the great designers of the era, notably Jules Leleu, whose works reflect this same pursuit of elegance, simplicity of form, and sophistication of materials. It should be noted, however, that no attribution to Jules Leleu is claimed here, as the lamp, to the best of our knowledge, bears no signature that would allow for such a determination. It is presented for what it is: a very beautiful French creation in the Art Deco style, particularly representative of its era. In excellent condition The lamp is in excellent condition, its opaline glass having retained all its freshness and delicate pink hue. Its sculptural form allows it to fit naturally on an Art Deco console table, a piece of furniture from the 1940s-1950s, a chest of drawers made of precious wood, or in a contemporary interior seeking a few striking antique pieces. A particularly elegant decorative piece, whose proportions--approximately 35 cm in height--allow it to make a significant statement without being overpowering.
