Richly chiseled bronze table mirror - Neo-Renaissance style, 19th century Highly decorative bronze table mirror, featuring rich openwork and high-relief decoration of scrolls, volutes, and foliage. The upper section is adorned with a remarkable feminine mascaron with a radiant hairstyle, while the lower section features a fantastical mascaron surrounded by foliage. The sides are enlivened by large plant-inspired volutes, giving the piece as a whole a particularly dynamic composition. The bronze has a beautiful antique brown patina, with the reliefs naturally lighter on the protruding parts. The central mirror has a scalloped shape that follows the design of the frame. The piece reflects the Neo-Renaissance/historicist style of the second half of the 19th century, drawing inspiration from
