Description

Charming portrait of a dog, depicting a small tricolour terrier seated facing forward on a red cushion. The dog, probably a smooth-haired Fox Terrier type, is portrayed with great naturalism. The deliberately restrained composition focuses all attention on the animal. The deep red of the cushion adds a striking touch of colour and contrasts elegantly with the dark brown tones of the background. This painting belongs to the tradition of pet portraiture, particularly popular in the late 19th and early 20th centuries. Oil on canvas, unsigned. European School, circa 1900. The canvas remains on its original keyed stretcher and is offered unframed.
