The piece is crafted from exquisite cherry wood with warm tones, whose grain lends the piece great depth and character. The rectangular top, which extends slightly beyond the sides and is framed by a border, retains beautiful proportions for a desk of this period. With its construction, elegant turned legs, numerous drawers, and the warmth of
